It is important that your soil drains well when you water through the winter. A relatively quick technique [Soji] helps! We'll review various winter care, lighting and storage options for indoor and outdoor!

[Soji] Do you have trees with compacted top soil? Bring them in, with your table cover, tools and some fresh soil, and we will show you how to clean that crusty top layer for healthier roots this winter!
